Trading Psychology

Psychology is an integral part of trading. Without the correct mindset you are doomed to repeat bad habits. Additionally if you do not understand the psychology of market participants then trading success becomes even more elusive. This course is an intense 1 week instruction covering trading and market psychology. It is geared towards the beginner who wants to learn from the ground up or the experienced trader that needs a refresher course. The class, instructed live by a 25 year currency trading veteran, meets for a total of 7.5 hours.

Do not expect to become a Sigmund Fraed from this class however be prepared to do some heavy thinking and serious soul searching.

Day 1

Day one we dive right into a discussion about taking responsibility for your actions and aligning your mental environment for trading success. It will be a day of learning to understand risk while creating consistency.

Day 2

The second day will be filled with perception and perspective. Wrong market perception can lead to the wrong market perspective. Learn how to view markets from the correct perspective. A day of thinking outside the box.

Day 3

On the third day we switch gears with a little math to quantify emotions. We will use probabilities to sculpt our thinking for trading success. By using probabilities of actions we can eliminate emotional risk.

Day 4

Day four is all about beliefs and how we can control those beliefs. First we will do some personal soul searching, and then we will define our beliefs and finally develop ways to work with those beliefs.

Day 5

On the last day of class we pull it all together incorporating everything we learned for the week. We are truly learning to think like a professional trader and looking at the big picture.

Upon completion of the course the student will be able to apply psychological factors to their trading style that will enhance their overall trading experience. Questions during class are encouraged and after class the instructor is available for additional help. A lot of information is taught in one week and no one is expected to understand everything in the week; therefore the instructor is available for questions any time after the class has been completed.
